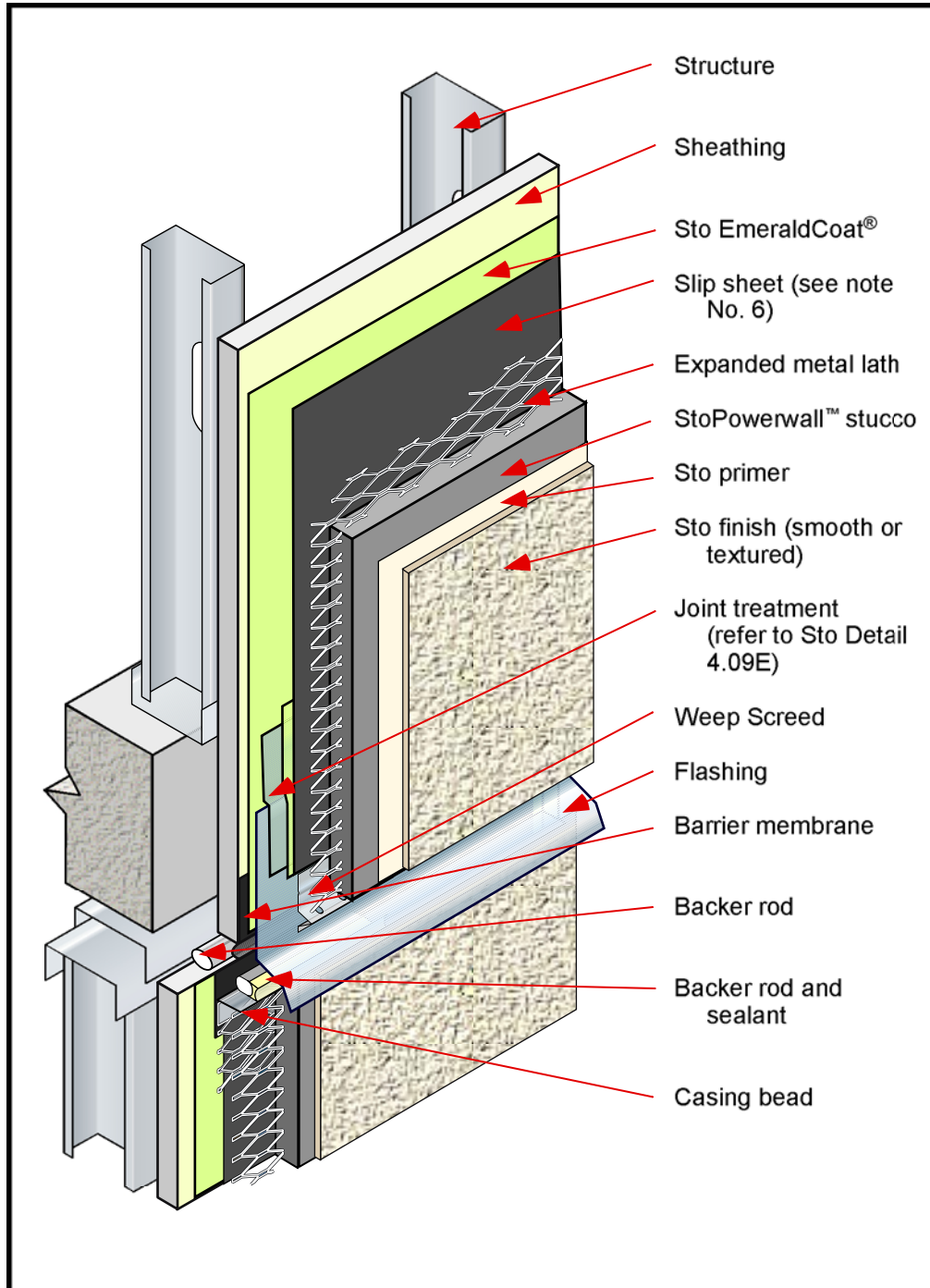


StoPowerwall™ NExT Floor Line Joint

Detail No.: 4.50 E

Date: February 2009



Notes:

- 1] Do not attach upper sheathing to nested track. Only attach lower sheathing to nested track.
- 2] The maximum allowable sheathing span at the floor line is 8" (200mm) or as recommended by the sheathing manufacturer.
- 3] A barrier membrane is installed over the joint in the sheathing to provide air barrier continuity and secondary weather protection at the joint location.
- 4] Provide a minimum 3/4" (20mm) joint to accommodate deflection of the floor slab.
- 5] Install a flashing to direct water beyond the face of the cladding below.
- 6] Provide slip sheet between Sto EmeraldCoat® and metal lath: minimum one layer building paper. Paper may be omitted when permitted by the local code authority or when paper-backed stucco lath is used.

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
