Title: StoCast Sample Technician

Location: Atlanta, GA 30336 (Offsite Warehouse – SW Atlanta)

Reports to: StoCast Production Supervisor

Purpose:

Sto Corp. (Sto), a domestic and global innovation leader of building envelope systems and high-performance facades, is seeking skilled **StoCast Sample Technician**. The ideal candidate will be responsible for StoCast brick sample production. This role requires a creative, self-directed individual with a high attention to detail who can maintain a schedule and produce high quality customer samples.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities (includes, but not limited to):

- Manage incoming orders and schedule production of custom samples either working alone or with a small production team.
- Prepare tinted products for production of samples.
- Utilize specialized tools to create high quality samples matching customer requirements.
- Maintain inventories of raw material, sample supplies and packaging materials.
- Prepare samples for shipment and work with local warehouse team to ship samples as scheduled.
- Create BOM's (bill of materials) for eventual mass production of samples.
- Develop detailed work instructions for manufacturing to ensure repeatable production of initial samples.
- Work with production teams to train technicians, scale up and produce finished products meeting quality standards.
- Cross-train and learn function of various production line assignments in order to fill in as needed for absences.
- Cleanup and daily housekeeping responsibilities.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Education & Experience:

- High school diploma or GED required.
- 1-3 years' experience working with your hands and hand-tools producing some type of finished product, ideally in an industrial manufacturing environment.

- 1-2 years' hands-on experience in paint, plaster, stucco and/or drywall application is desirable.

Knowledge & Skills:

- Ability to differentiate and make color adjustments.
- Familiar with OSHA & EPA practices and policies.
- Understand, practice, and enforce safe work practices.
- Must have basic problem-solving skills and mechanical aptitude.
- Must have manual dexterity sufficient to operate a wide variety of small hand tools, scales, spatula, hand trucks, utility knife, mixing and packaging machinery and computer equipment.
- Knowledge of data software: MS365 and SAP.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and team building experience.
- Able to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- Excellent math skills required.
- Exceptional attention to detail.
- Strong organizational skills.
- Self-motivated individual - desire to take the initiative.
- Ability to continuously multi-task.
- Must be able to maintain excellent attendance.
- Must be flexible to work any shift and overtime as business requires.

- Work is almost exclusively inside and ambient conditions can be hot or cold depending on the season.
- Regularly exposed to moving mechanical parts, and occasionally to airborne particulates.
