#### Purpose:

The ideal candidate will be responsible for the supervision of the Quality/Color Lab and perform testing on all incoming raw materials and finish goods to ensure that our customers receive high quality products.

### Essential Duties & Responsibilities (includes, but not limited to):

- Organize and direct the daily activities of the lab.
- Responsible for conducting and overseeing quality assurance and quality control, collecting, analyzing and interpreting lab results.
- Manage all Quality Assurance personnel to ensure compliance with health & safety and operational standards.
- Test incoming raw materials and outgoing finished goods to verify that they meet internal specifications and fall within process capability.
- Knowledge of the operation of viscometers, pH meters, scales, mixing machines and finish/paint applications.
- Making color assessments and adjustments for tinted production batches.
- Read and interpret statistical process data to improve manufacturing processes.
- Conduct process Quality Control and Hygiene inspections and audits in the manufacturing plant.
- Responsible for initiating and follow up of Correction Action Requests (CARs).
- Lead Safety engagement activities to include the maintenance of Safety Data Sheets (SDSs).
- Complete reports including Statistical Process Control Charts, project status summaries or ISO work instructions.
- Facilitate and Co-Lead Plant ISO 9001 and 14001 initiatives and projects with Plant Leadership team.
- Be knowledgeable of the requirements of the ISO 9001: Quality and 14001: Environmental standards as they apply to the laboratory and overall quality systems in the plant.



- Write and maintain clear and understandable Job procedures for the Quality Assurance testing process in ISO-9001-14001 work instruction format.
- Maintain clean working environment including clear work surfaces, clean and wellmaintained equipment, clearly labeled storage areas, etc.
- Ability to communicate effectively with sales, customer service and occasionally customers in solving problems and providing excellent customer service and color matching expertise.
- Lead all E/H/S activities for the plant, to include OSHA training, Incident Investigation, safety committee, annual hearing and respirator testing, and maintaining SHARPS certification.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
